Lina Gebremariam (CAQH CORE Manager) discussed the proposed updates to the Phase IV 278 Infrastructure Rule and how CAQH CORE arrived at the need to evaluate opportunities to strengthen the existing rule requirements. Lina Gebremariam (CAQH CORE Manager) reviewed the proposed scope of the potential Draft Phase IV Response Time Requirements and reminded participants that scoping the applicability of the proposed adjustments and new requirements is a critical part of the Task Group's responsibility. Remind SMEs to report back to executive sponsors with updates on Task Group efforts. Summary of Phase IV Task Group Discussion: Chuck Ververka (Michigan Department of Community Health) expressed concern about the workbook deadline of Friday, May 29th and asked CAQH CORE Staff to consider extending the deadline as well as to confirm that this is the correct date. Erin Weber (CAQH CORE Director) confirmed that Friday, May 29th is the current deadline for the workbook and asked Task Group Participants to let CAQH CORE Staff know if after reviewing the workbook, they think that they'd need additional time for completion.
