4. Review CSWG Straw Poll #1 Results (Doc #3).	 Bob Bowman (Director, CORE) reviewed Comments Received on Part A: Draft Substantive Updates. Summary of CSWG Discussion. Michael Denison (Change Healthcare) questioned whether a Work Group will be created to address security versions that are deprecated in the future. Bob Bowman (Director, CORE) agreed that being able to quickly update the standardized version is important and explained that this is one of the reason the current Work Group convened, as there are currently deprecated versions of standards that the group is working to update. Health McCommas (AMA) commented on Section 3.8.1 Maintenance and asked if there is a link to CAQH CORE's maintenance process linked in the proposed rule language, as it could improve understanding. Bob Bowman (Director, CORE) agreed and stated that CAQH CORE CSWG Co-chairs and Staff would update the rule to include a footnote with a hyperlink to the maintenance process, so the reference is included in the rule itself. Emily TenEyck (Manager, CORE) reviewed Comments Received on Part B: Draft Substantive Updates to Select Rule Requirements. Summary of CSWG Discussion. Health McCommas (AMA) asked if CAQH CORE would be able to provide a further education on OAuth 2.0 as an authorization standard vs. an authentication standard. Emily TenEyck mentioned that a summary of OAuth 2.0 will be included during the next Work Group call and that CAQH CORE Co-chairs and Staff will be conducting additional research over the coming weeks on the topic. Brian Handspicker (IRIS Health Solutions) asked if there would be motivation from an organization that has already invested in X.509 Digital Certificate to also invest in OAuth 2.0 and not X.509 Digital Certificate would not longer be optional. Emily TenEyck indicated that the X.509 Digital Certificate would likely be kept as the base requirement and OAuth 2.0 would be optional, but that addi	Discussion
