	 John Kelly (Edifecs) responded that it does not matter if it is an intermediary or not and that when an organization has the FHIR output and the X12 278, they need to encapsulate it into the X12 275. Furthermore, the X12 275 is clear for what should be done if it is structured versus unstructured, but FHIR is a hybrid of structured and unstructured and it is not clear what that looks like inside the 	
	 envelope. He questioned whether this draft rule would have a gap and recognizes Bob's sentiment that we are going to move forward with what we have, and that additional work will need to be done. Rachel Foerster (CAQH CORE Consultant) supported that we still need clarity about what is coming out of HL7 FHIR PAS to create an X12 278 and/or an X12 275. John Kelly (Edifecs) agrees that it is unclear and questioned whose role it is to provide clarification. He asked which vehicle to use to establish a standard operating model for the industry (e.g., an operating rule, an X12 IG, a Da Vinci IG). Bob Bowman (CAQH CORE Director) stated that CAQH CORE can mediate these discussions through work groups or through relationships with HL7 and X12. CAQH CORE can bring information back to this work group for further discussion. Rachel Foerster (CAQH CORE Consultant) agrees and thinks CAQH CORE could participate on HL7 conversations and clarify what is coming out of the HL7 PAS IG to create an X12 275. Bob Bowman (CAQH CORE Director) stated the need to do some groundwork for the work group to bring the topic full circle. He said it is a great opportunity for industry to come together to identify a solution. He thanked John for the discussion.
