1. Introductions, Welcome, and Antitrust Guidelines (Doc #1 Slide 2)	 Pete Benziger (Senior Manager, CORE) opened the call and welcomed everyone to the group. Pete Benziger (Senior Manager, CORE) reviewed the call agenda, roll-call, and antitrust guidelines. 	Discussion
2. Subgroup Level-Set (Doc #1 Slides 3-9)	 Bob Bowman (Principal, CORE) provided a high-level overview of CAQH CORE mission, vision, and industry role. Bob Bowman (Principal, CORE) introduced the Co-Chairs to the group and passed the call for them to introduce themselves to the group. They include Randy Gabel (Ohio Health) Olga Khabinskay (HBMA, WCH), Mahesh Siddanatai (Centene), and Megan Soccorso (Gainwell Technologies). Bob Bowman (Principal, CORE) reviewed scope, goals, and timelines for the group. Bob Bowman (Principal, CORE) discussed the approach and progression of operating rule development CAQH CORE deploys for drafting rules. Bob Bowman (Principal, CORE) reviewed participant expectations and responsibilities for subgroup calls and any additional work, such as straw polling and call preparation. 	Discussion
3.Research Overview (Doc #1 Slides 10-12)	 Pete Benziger (Senior Manager, CORE) reviewed a summary of findings and publications from the CAQH CORE Health Care Claims focus groups, industry interviews, and stakeholder polling. Pete Benziger (Senior Manager, CORE) introduced topic areas for operating rule development. These opportunity areas include telehealth place of service (POS) assignment, value-based payment supplementary diagnosis transmission, coordination of benefits (COB) data content requirements, and improving the use of the claim acknowledgment 277CA transaction. Pete Benziger (Senior Manager, CORE) also invited participants to share any additional topics that CAQH CORE should consider in future call discussions. 	Discussion
4. Initial Areas of Opportunity (Doc #1 Slides 13-17)	 Bob Bowman (Principal, CORE) introduced the topic of aligning industry towards a common approach for telehealth POS claim submission. With the end of the Public Health Emergency (PHE) coming, organizations have expressed concern around losing a common framework for place of service and modifier use for telehealth claim billing. Randy Gabel (Ohio Health) spoke to the complications of varying telehealth billing and confusion around billing requirements. He expressed that industry is at risk in losing out on opportunities to provide patients with telehealth services if billing for these services is not properly streamlined. Bob Bowman (Principal, CORE) introduced the topic of supporting value-based payment with the 837 transaction as a way to align on best practice pathways for supporting supplementary diagnosis submissions. CAQH CORE is launching a VBP specific subgroup to tackle issue of best practices for VBP related workflows and data exchanges. The work and discussions being held in the health care claims subgroup will help to inform some of the work being done over there, and vice versa. Bob Bowman (Principal, CORE) introduced the topic of standardizing COB elements within the 837 transaction to 	Discussion

	 remediate questions on COB payments and care attribution. Mahesh Siddanatai (Centene) spoke to the challenges providers are facing when interacting with health plans that have varying COB data requirements for them to process secondary claims. This is a major challenge in the industry today. Bob Bowman (Principal, CORE) introduced the topic of improving the utility of the 277CA transaction. He noted that CORE understands this transaction is not universally adopted by the industry and therefore the discussion on the issue may be narrower. Further, he emphasized the importance for providing as much granular detail back to providers on the status of front-end errors with submitted claims. Current organizations who do utilize this transaction vary on the use of the associated error reporting codes and their meanings. Megan Soccorso (Gainwell Technologies) spoke to the importance of accurate error reporting to get faster, more accurate claims back into a health plans system for quicker revenue cycle windows. 	
5. Rule Development Discussion – Telehealth Claim POS Codes (Doc #1 Slides 18-21)	 Bob Bowman (Principal, CORE) introduced the topic of aligning on an approach to telehealth claim submission. With the end of the Public Health Emergency (PHE) coming, organizations have expressed concern around losing a common framework provided by PHE regulations for place of service and modifier use for telehealth claim billing. CAQH CORE recognizes that some of this is dependent on policy, and CAQH CORE does not write rules for policy. However, understanding the policy help to inform the use of data content necessary to successfully transmit these transactions. 	Discussion
6. Next Steps (Doc #1 Slides 22-23)	 Pete Benziger (Senior Manager, CORE) introduced next steps to the group, including action items and timelines. These include: Completion of Straw Poll #1 between: April 17 – April 28, 2023 CORE Staff to analyze Straw Poll results and draft call documents: April 28 – May 3, 2023 Next Subgroup call to be held on Thursday, May 4th at 2:00PM EST. Summary of CSG Discussion: Terrance Cunningham (AHA) asked whether the topic of telehealth POS claims includes only professional claims, or institutional as well.
