Ms. Campbell noted that the RWG is focused on three sets of operating rules related to value-based payments, health care claims, and EFT/ERA enrollment. Ms. Campbell also noted that the results of Straw Poll #2, which focused on the draft Health Care Claims Data Content rules for the X12 837 and X12 277CA transactions, will be reviewed in today's meeting. Ms. Campbell also reiterated the timeline, noting the RWG was on track to have considered each rule set by late November/early December 2023, with final approval in late December 2023. 	Discussion
